

Setting Up Your Gemini Account

Welcome to Crypto Yield Hunter!


The goal of this service is to make your money work for you by helping you earn passive income from your crypto investments.

In this guide, I'm going to take you through the process for how to set up an account on Gemini, a centralized crypto exchange.

You'll need a crypto exchange account to buy stablecoins — which we'll use for staking — and Ethereum, which we'll use to pay transaction fees for some of our recommendations.


Without further ado, let's get started ...

Step 1. Make sure you are on webpage Gemini.com. It should look like this:




Click "Get Started" to start the registration process.

Step 2. Fill in your basic info and then click "Next."




You'll receive email from Gemini. Open in and click on the link inside to confirm your email. You'll then be taken to the next page to confirm your phone number. This is necessary as it'll allow you to use your phone as additional security step when logging in.


Step 3. Fill in your address, as shown below.



Step 4. Confirm your identity by entering your date of birth and Social Security Number (SSN).



Step 5. Verify your identity using either a valid passport or driver's license.



Congratulations! You've just opened your Gemini account.
